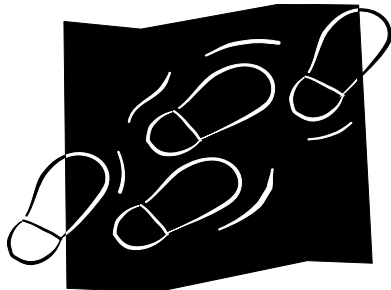

Display Hours

Your work will be on display during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. as well as weekday evenings when meetings are scheduled. The building is locked during non-business hours.

Liability

You are solely responsible for loss, damage, destruction and to adequately insure the display. In no case will the City of Prior Lake, Prior Lake Optimist Club or Prior Lake-Savage Area School's Community Education accept responsibility for your private property.

Display Decisions

The determination of what is displayed and when is the responsibility of the Prior Lake Optimist Club's Display Committee and the City of Prior Lake.

Display Intervals

The Prior Lake Optimist Club's Display Committee will coordinate the rotation of displays at reasonable intervals.

Sale of Art Work

The City of Prior Lake will not accept payment for work purchased from you by the public. Nor will we allow anyone but you to remove the piece from City Hall. All inquiries or payment will be directed to you. Your contact information should be displayed with your work.

A Caveat

The City reserves the right to refuse to display an artist's work if it is deemed to be inappropriate. The final authority to make such a decision rests with the City Manager.
