### **City of Prior Lake's Annual Clean-up Day is April 18**

Prior Lake's 21st Annual Clean-up Day is Saturday, April 18 from 8 a.m. – noon at the Twin Oaks Middle School parking lot, 15860 Fish Point Road SE. Prior Lake, Credit River and Spring Lake Township residents can participate with proof of residency.

The emphasis for Clean-Up Day is recycling; therefore, only certain items will be accepted for drop-off at the event. The gate fee is only \$5. Extra fees will apply for certain items and large loads. Acceptable materials include tires, major appliances, electronics, motor vehicle batteries, scrap iron and yard waste.

Up to four passenger tires, one appliance, one electronic item, batteries, metals and yard waste are allowed per vehicle. Large loads, trailers, non-recyclables and additional items are extra cost. Residents can also drop off good-quality usable furniture and household goods for the Bridging program. Members of the Prior Lake Lions and Rotary clubs will be on hand to collect items to distribute to needy families.
