RECYCLING

The emphasis for Clean-Up Day is recycling; therefore, only certain items will be accepted for drop-off at the event. The gate fee is only \$20. Extra fees will apply for certain items and large loads. Acceptable materials include tires, major appliances, electronics, motor vehicle batteries, scrap iron and yard waste.

Up to four passenger tires, one appliance, one electronic item, batteries, metals, and yard waste are allowed per vehicle. Large loads, trailers, non-recyclables and additional items are extra. All tires need to be removed from bikes, mowers, BBQs, etc. Call City Hall at (952) 447-9800 or Public Works at (952) 447-9830 for additional information.

Residents can also drop off good-quality usable furniture and household goods for the Bridging program. Members of the Prior Lake Lions and Rotary clubs will be on hand to collect items to distribute to needy families.
