### Filing Period for Prior Lake Mayor and City Council Seats Opens Tuesday, Aug. 25

Affidavits of Candidacy for Mayor and two City Council seats will be available beginning Tuesday, Aug. 25, 2009 at 8 a.m. through Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2009 until 5 p.m. The packets for the Affidavits of Candidacy are available at Prior Lake City Hall, 4646 Dakota St. Se in Prior Lake, upstairs in the city's finance department. The term of Mayor Jack Haugen and the terms of councilors Chad LeMair and Warren Erickson will expire at the end of 2009. The term for the three seats will be three years, January 2010 through December 2012.

Candidates must:

- be a resident of Prior Lake for at least 30 days before the election;
- be eligible to vote in a City of Prior Lake election;
- be 21 years of age upon assuming office;
- not be a candidate for any other office in the same election.
