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Poor Weather Delays Habitat for Humanity House Move to Dec. 16

In a partnership between the City of Prior Lake and Habitat for Humanity, an existing Prior Lake home was to be moved Dec. 9 to city-owned property at 3631 170th St. near County Rd. 13 in southern Prior Lake. The house move has been delayed to Wednesday, Dec. 16 at 9 p.m., because of predicted poor weather. The new date is also subject to change, depending on weather.

The relatively short, two-hour move from 16046 Tahinka Pl. near Spring Lake Regional Park is not expected to require additional police or fire personnel, but some tree trimming is expected along County Rd. 12. The morning move is timed to lower costs, avoid traffic delays and minimize momentary disruptions in utility service for area residents. Residents along the moving route are being notified.

Plans for the future residence is consistent with the City's 2030 Comprehensive Plan to work with the county housing, the redevelopment authority and other agencies and non-profit groups to achieve diverse, affordable, high-quality housing.

The appraised value of the city-owned lot is \$58,000. Habitat for Humanity will partially compensate the city \$22,000 for the parcel.
