



Prior Lake to be honored at Twins Game

City of Prior Lake residents will be honored at the Metrodome during the Minnesota Twins' "Prior Lake Night at the Dome" night Saturday, Aug. 18 at 6:05 p.m. On-field ceremonies will begin at about 5:30 p.m.

The Twins will also celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 1987 World Series Championship that night. Many of the 1987 World Series team members will take part in the on-field ceremony preceding the game between the Twins and the Texas Rangers.

There will be 450 discounted seats in Lower Reserved Section 115 along the right field line available through the Prior Lake Chamber of Commerce and the City of Prior Lake, the event co-sponsors. The cost is \$25 per ticket. Prior Lake baseball fans may also purchase discount coupons good for concession food and beverages during the game.

In addition, the City of Prior Lake is providing free bus transportation for the first 200 people to and from the Metrodome on game day. There will also be many events and activities going on during the afternoon at the Plaza just outside the Dome.

The First Pitch will be thrown by a lucky Prior Lake area resident. That pitch will be auctioned off to the highest bidder during Prior Lake's Lakefront Days July 31 through Aug. 5. The proceeds go to the Chamber's Dick Underferth Humanitarian Award.
