Prior Lake residents are welcome to a ribbon cutting ceremony and open house for the new senior center / community room on Tuesday, Jan. 8 from 10 a.m. to noon at the Prior Lake Library Resource Center (formerly Premier Dance Academy), 16210 Eagle Creek Ave. The building will be open until 2 p.m. that day.

The ceremony will include words from the Mayor, a formal naming of the facility, refreshments and music by the duo "Higher Ground."

The City of Prior Lake will be offering active older adult (adults 55 and older) and community programming at the Library Resource Center space which was recently renovated for that purpose. The City hired part-time senior/ community center coordinator Debbie Carlberg to operate the facility which will initially be open Tuesdays through Thursdays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Residents can come and relax with a cup of coffee, talk to some friends, read a book or participate in scheduled activities. In January there will be Latin and ballroom line dancing, a "Preventing Falls in Your Home" presentation by Gentiva, Bingo, cards/board games, a monthly birthday party with cake and more.
