City of Prior Lake Searching For Senior Center Task Force Members

The City of Prior Lake is searching for Prior Lake residents interested in serving on its Senior Center Task Force. The task force is anticipated to meet five to seven times (for 1.5 to 2 hours each) to investigate creating a senior center utilizing the 6,000-square-foot Premiere Dance Academy location in the Library.

The task force will consider:

- Whether the space meets minimum criteria to be a senior center?
- What programs would seniors want to see?
- What the cost of improvements will be?
- What resources are available to offer such programs?
- Who will pay for programs?

A final report will be prepared and shared with the City Council in August so that recommendations of the task force could be considered for implementation in September or October.
