



SNOWMOBILE ANNOUNCEMENT

TO PRESERVE THIS COMMUNITY'S INVESTMENT IN ITS DOWNTOWN STREETS, THE CITY OF PRIOR LAKE STRICTLY ENFORCES ITS SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE

Key Downtown Points

Snowmobiles PERMITTED:

- Hwy. 13 Regional Trail
- Dakota St. and Pleasant St.
- Hastings Ave. from Dakota to Main Ave.
- Regional trail as marked in Lakefront Park from Hwy. 13 through the park to Prior Lake
- Snowmobiles permitted to cross Main Ave. at right angles only.

Snowmobiles PROHIBITED:

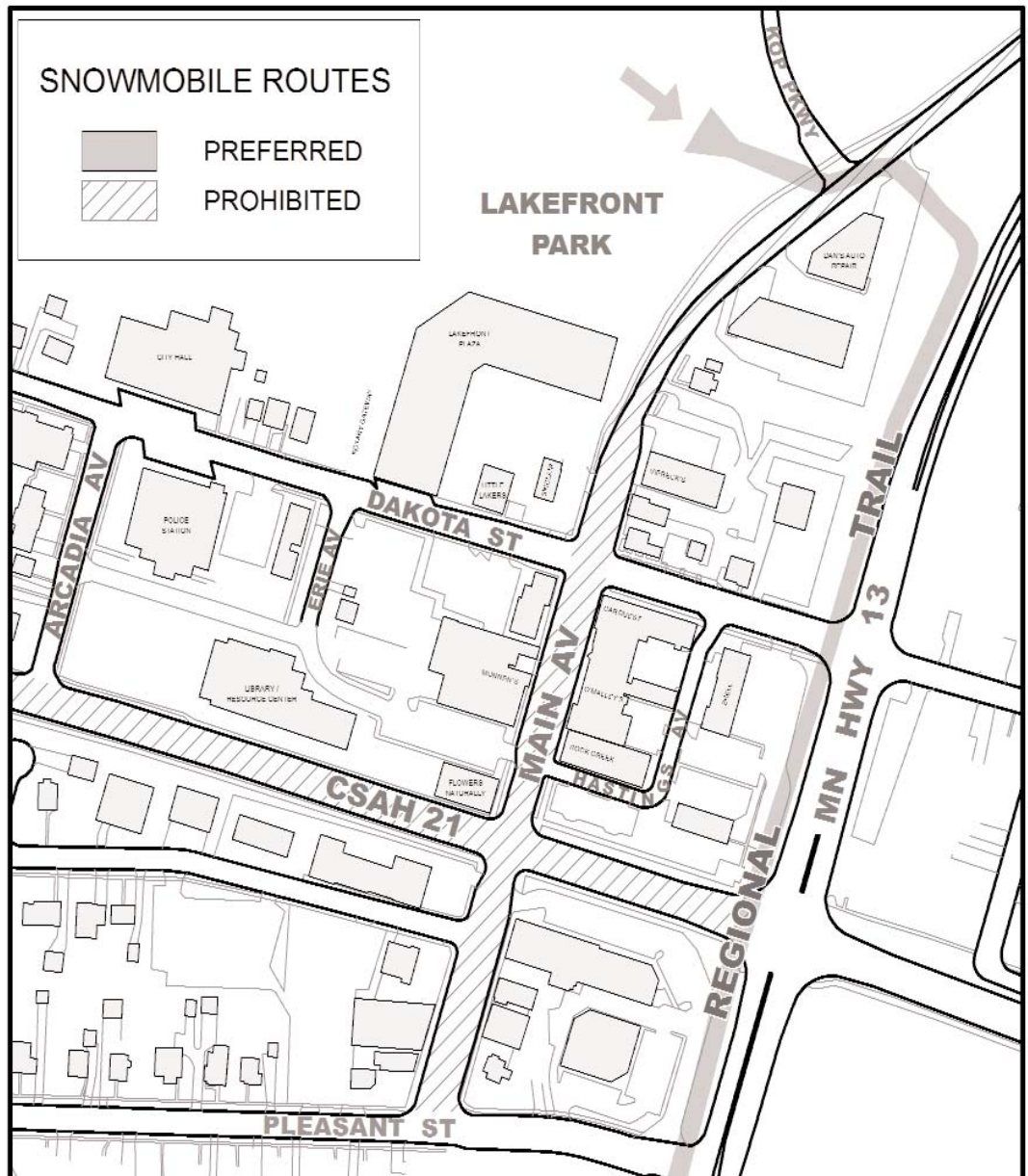
- Main Ave.
- County Rd. 21 west of Hwy. 13
- Any sidewalk/trail unless designated for snowmobiling

ENFORCEMENT:

- The Prior Lake Police Department will patrol the downtown area by car to enforce these regulations and citations will be issued.
- Speed limit is 10 mph on local streets.
- Snowmobile hours: Sunday to Thursday 7 a.m. to 11 p.m.; Friday and Saturday 7 a.m. to 2 a.m .

WARNING, THIN ICE!

The aerator in the Lakefront FiN Pond adjacent to the park entrance will continue to function this winter. A warning fence and flashing light are now in place. **Please stay away from this area.** The fountain on the east side of the pond's floating bridge has been shut down for the winter.
