\$1 for each circulator bus ride in the Prior Lake system. Correct fare is required. Drivers do not make change. Local Laker Link punch cards are also accepted.

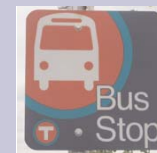

With the new Local Laker Link shuttle, you can ride for FREE to Valleyfair, the Workforce Center and Southbridge -- and with a connection, go almost anywhere!



In addition to the **Local Laker Link**, the City of Prior Lake offers the weekday, nonstop express transit service to downtown Minneapolis known as **Laker Lines (Route 490)**.

In April 2006, a new park-and-ride location was established at Shepherd of the Lake Lutheran Church on the Shepherd's Path campus (13760 McKenna Road NW) and third morning and afternoon routes were added to better accommodate riders who rely on Laker Lines for their fast, carefree downtown commutes.

Board the shuttle in Lakefront Park or in downtown Prior Lake and ride for FREE to:

The Burnsville Transit Station is one of the key transit hubs in the metro area. From there, you can get virtually anywhere. And now, Local Laker Lines riders have access to it. If you live in Prior Lake, simply board the free Laker Lines shuttle at Lakefront Park or Main Avenue. After stops at Valleyfair and the Scott County Workforce Center, you will arrive at the Southbridge development off County Road 18 and Highway 169. At Southbridge, look for Shakopee Transit Bus 495 which will take you on to the Burnsville Transit Center.

If you take a Laker Lines morning route into Minneapolis and need to get back to the park-and-ride at SOTL before the late afternoon runs, now there is a way. At 11:24, board MVTA Route 465A at Marquette and 4th in Minneapolis. That will take you to Burnsville Transit Station, where you will arrive at 11:56 a.m. At noon, board Scott Route 497, which will take you on to the Southbridge Center at 12:20 p.m. There, board the Laker Lines shuttle, which will take you, free of charge, to the SOTL park-and-ride.
