Traffic Visibility. No walls, fences, structures, trees, shrubs, vegetation or other obstructions shall be permitted in any yard when it poses a danger to traffic by obscuring the view from any street, roadway, or alley; except as provided below.

- (1) Visibility from any street or roadway shall be unobstructed above the height of 2 1/2 feet and below 5 feet within the triangle described as beginning from a point at the intersection of the extension of the existing curb lines of the two streets, and extending a distance of 50 feet along the edge of each street. This defines two sides of the triangle. The third side is a line connecting the end points of the two sides described above.
- (2) Visibility from the intersection of any street or roadway and an alley shall be unobstructed above the height of 2 1/2 feet and below 5 feet within the triangle described as beginning from a point at the intersection of the extension of the existing curb lines or pavement edges or if unpaved, the edge of the traveled surface, of the street and alley, and extending a distance of 15 feet along the edge of each street. This defines two sides of the triangle. The third side is a line connecting the end points of the sides described above.
- (3) Visibility from the intersection of any two alleys shall be unobstructed above the height of 2 1/2 feet and below 5 feet within the triangle described as beginning from a point at the intersection of the extension of the existing curb lines or pavement edges of the two alleys, and extending a distance of 10 feet along the edge of each alley. This defines two sides of the triangle. The third side is a line connecting the end points of the two sides described above.
