The information provided in this brochure is intended to help you license your pet and answer your questions about pet ownership.

Did you know....

- ♥ Every dog and cat over three months of age must be licensed with the City.
- ♥ The licensing fee is lower if your pet is neutered or spayed.
- ♥ Every dog and cat must be vaccinated against rabies. Include the certificate of rabies vaccination from your vet with your license application.
- ♥ After payment of the license fee and providing proof of rabies vaccination, you will be issued a license and tag to fasten to the collar of your pet.
- ♥ Your pet's license will be valid until December 31 of the following year.

Information You Need To Know

The City of Prior Lake recognizes that pets are an important part of many families. The health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City and pets living in the City requires the City to regulate the ownership and keeping of dogs and cats.

- All dogs and cats must be leashed.
- No person shall maintain more than three dogs, cats or combination of without obtaining a kennel license.
- Dogs and cats are not permitted on beach areas, athletic fields or nature center areas.
- Solid waste from your dog or cat must be immediately removed from public property or private property of another and disposed of in a trash container.
- It is your responsibility to prevent your dog or cat from being a nuisance as in frequent barking, chasing vehicles and fighting with other cats and dogs, etc.
